Book Club Discussion Questions

1. Cat & Taylor grew up together & have always been friends. How do you feel about friends becoming lovers?
2. Taylor's call sign is "Wizard" because he's clever at getting out of sticky situations. When & how did he earn this nickname in his relationship with Cat?
3. Taylor's SEAL team plays a role in his relationship with Cat. How does that pressure work in their favor? How does it work against them?
4. The SEAL team wives are always trying to set up Taylor with a suitable woman. Have you ever played matchmaker? How did it turn out?
5. Cat is a carpenter & contractor. How does being a woman in a man's world influence her life? Her family dynamic? Her relationship with Taylor?
6. Cat feels pressure on two fronts: 1. To be feminine like her mother & 4 sisters; 2. To follow in her dad's footsteps & become a partner in the family business. Can she resolve the two? How would you resolve the dilemma she's in?
7. Cat's mom says to her, "Of all my daughters, you're the most like your father. But you need to be you, Catarina. You need to live your life. Live your dreams." How can you encourage a daughter, friend, sister, mother in your life to live their own dreams? Are you living yours?
8. Taylor's fantasies about Cat were good; he hoped the real thing would be even better. What part do fantasies play in your life? Are there times when the "real thing" turned out to be even better than you'd imagined?
9. Cat & Taylor took their relationship from friends to lovers. Once that happens, can a couple ever go back to being "just friends"? In your opinion, is the risk worth it?
10. In talking about her job in the family business, Cat says, "Just because I did what I was supposed to do doesn't mean it was the right thing to do." How does "supposed to" play in your life? Is what you "should" do always the right thing to do?
